### **Grand Turk, Turks & Caicos**

Let the name fool you, Grand Turk, of the Turks & Caicos islands, may be small but it's packed with scenic punch and historic charm. This cruise to Grand Turk delivers you to this enchanted island outpost dotted with old windmills, grassy trails and picture-perfect beaches. Discover an oasis of green set in aquamarine seas, ringed by a pristine coral reef and the steep wall of the continental shelf.

### **Amber Cove, Dominican Republic**

In this world full of information on just about everything, Amber Cove is a throwback — it's the kind of quiet little spot you won't find on most maps. But you will find it — brimming with bars and pools, plus opportunities for lounging and shopping — to be the gateway to island paradise, Dominican-style. ### **Panama Canal (Partial Transit)**

With its mouth located on the Atlantic near the city of Colón, this decades-in-the-making canal flows past the lush green scenery surrounding the canal's impressive Gatún Locks, on its way towards the expanse of Lake Gatún itself. You'll go with the flow as you enter — and exit — the lake through these locks, getting two chances to take in up-close views of the land.

### **Limón, Costa Rica**

This is your gateway to the ecotourism treasures of Costa Rica when you cruise to Limón. From here you can soar above rainforests, feel the mist from tumbling waterfalls, and swim in clear Caribbean seas. Limón, Costa Rica, sits at the center of the Caribbean coast's best eco-adventures.
