TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

A government-issued photo I.D. is required (such as a driver's license). Must be 21 years old with a valid I.D. for wine tasting.

PAYMEN

\$300 per person deposit due at the time of booking to confirm your reservation. Final payment due to AAA by March 7, 2016.

CANCELLATION/PENALTIES

A \$25 per person cancellation fee will be charged by Discoveries in addition to any other supplier's fees. From March 7, 2016 to day of departure no refunds unless a replacement traveler is provided by the registered participant.


