#### INSURANCE

Alaska is not a frigid land of ice and snow! The interior around Fairbanks is warm during the summer. Pack for a variety of temperatures; layers work best. Daytime, casual clothes and comfortable walking shoes are fine. For cruising, evenings require casual or semi-formal attire, with one formal night.

#### BAGGAGE

Due to limited facilities charter airline regulations for flights between Fairbanks and Dawson City restrict passengers to two checked bags with a maximum combined weight of 50 lbs. and one carry-on item under 13 lbs. All fees for exceeding those limits will be the traveler's responsibility.
