Thursday, July 21:

6:00AM: Motorcoach will depart from Lancaster, AC Moore Store located in Lancaster Shopping Center on the Oregon Pike/ Route 272 side of the store.

7:00AM: Motorcoach will depart from Harrisburg, AAA Central Penn, 2301 Paxton Church Rd; travel to Somerset, Virginia's Piedmont region with appropriate rest and meal stops en route.

Unique discoveries await as we make our first stop at the **Market at Grelen**. Set on a gorgeous 600-acre tree nursery, this destination will allow you to connect with nature. We'll begin with an elegant luncheon in the garden's Wedding Pavilion. Following lunch, take part in a landscape design workshop with the Market at Grelen's owner and head horticulturist. Instruction will provide design basics regarding site assessment, master plan, budget and "right plant for right location" gardening. We will then depart for our guided tour of **Montpelier**, former President James Madison's home. It is acknowledged that James and Dolley Madison loved to entertain and Dolley was widely known as one of America's great hostesses. Our guided tour will introduce us to their life at Montpelier, after the presidency, and the people who visited them as well as the social customs and food traditions that kept their table bountiful. Venture out onto the grounds to join the excavation currently going on to reconstruct South Yard, an enslaved community site immediately adjacent to the Madison mansion. Learn the evolving story of the enslaved Virginians and their road to emancipation. We will then head to the **Omni Charlottesville Hotel** for a one night stay. This award-winning luxury hotel, lush with greenery, features a stunning, seven-story glassed-in atrium, making this a memorable stay. Freshen up before we enjoy an evening of conversation and wine pairings at the **C & O Restaurant** with our host Thomas Jefferson. **Bill Barker**, who has portrayed Jefferson for over 18 years, will transport us back in time to experience what it would be like to mingle with Mr. Jefferson. Bill has performed as Jefferson at the White House, Palace of Versailles and throughout the United States, Great Britain, France and the Las Vegas strip. An evening of fun and a special "farm to table" dinner that features locally sourced food will be one that you'll never forget! Hotel: *Omni Charlottesville Hotel* (Lunch, Dinner)





Friday, July 22:

We'll begin our day with a gourmet buffet breakfast at the hotel's **The Pointe** restaurant before departing for a tour of Thomas Jefferson's iconic home **Monticello**. "Monticello is the autobiographical masterpiece of Thomas Jefferson—designed and redesigned and built and rebuilt for more than forty years—and its gardens were a botanic showpiece, a source of food, and an experimental laboratory of ornamental and useful plants from around the world." Enjoy an in-depth guided walk of Jefferson's gardens followed by a **Meet the Gardener** segment with Monticello's professional staff. You'll participate in seasonal gardening activities, such as planting, harvesting, and sampling crops ranging from asparagus to baby root vegetables. We will complete our visit with a lite lunch at the museum's café. This vintage getaway takes us to **Walton's Mountain**. The **Walton's Mountain Museum** in Schuyler, Virginia was both the childhood home of Earl Hamner, creator of "The Waltons," and the inspirational town for the beloved TV series. Delight in the recreated sets of the show, like the Walton family living room, John-boy's bedroom and Godsey's store that truly portray Depression-era life. As we head for home take away a sense of nostalgia and wonderful memories of your Vintage Virginia getaway! (Breakfast, Lunch)
