TOUR ITINERARY:

Sunday, July 24: Depart for Ohio

12:00PM: Motorcoach will depart from Lancaster, AC Moore Store located in Lancaster Shopping Center on the Oregon Pike/Route 272 side of the store.

1:00PM: Motorcoach will depart from Harrisburg, AAA Central Penn, 2301 Paxton Church Rd; travel to Grove City, OH for hotel check in and an overnight stay. Enjoy dinner on your own at one of the local restaurants within walking distance from the hotel. Hotel: *Drury Inn*, Grove City, OH

Monday, July 25: Explore the Creation Museum

Enjoy a plentiful breakfast at the hotel, before checking out and making our way to the **Creation Museum** in Petersburg, KY. Be amazed as you enter the 70,000 square foot "walk through history" museum and experience the Bible brought to life. Exhibits within this fascinating museum are uniquely divided into spaces that allow for personal interaction with each of the 160 exhibits. Several parts of the museum, including the stunning forty-foot high portico with its cliff wall and floor-to-ceiling glass windows, flaunt open spaces and remarkable designs. See Adam and Eve as you walk through the Garden of Eden and smell the freshly-cut timbers in the busy work site of Noah's Ark. Dig up dinosaur bones—or come face to face with T. Rex. Take a journey through a visual presentation of the history of the world, where you will discover an interpretation of how science confirms biblical history. Creatures of all sizes inhabit the three gardens that accentuate the outdoor landscape at the Creation Museum. Turtles rest on the logs in the lake, sunning themselves, while a 12 foot topiary dinosaur strikes a pose in the rainforest garden. With over 6,000 plants and 500 varieties, the gardens display a rich palette of designs and colors. A perfect place for the hungry visitor is Noah's Café, where intricately designed bamboo walls and ceilings create a tropical feel and restful atmosphere. A 27 foot mural pictures the Ark resting on the mountains of Ararat. Be sure to step out onto the café's deck for a dramatic view of the museum landscape! In addition to the museum, the facility also houses a special effects theater, a planetarium, botanical gardens, a petting zoo and a gift shop. After your fun filled day exploring the museum, you'll check into your hotel and freshen up for dinner at the Cracker Barrel, in Florence.

Hotel: Holiday Inn Riverfront, Covington, KY (Breakfast, \$20 Dinner Voucher per person)

Tuesday, July 26: Experience the Ark Encounter & Visit the Garden of Hope

This morning enjoy a full breakfast at the hotel. Located in Williamstown, KY, the **Ark Encounter** will equip visitors to understand the reality of the events that are recorded in the book of Genesis in the Bible. This full-sized replica of Noah's Ark, at 510 feet long and more than 50 feet tall before the sail is added, is the largest wooden timber in the world. The Ark includes hundreds of different displays, including mock-ups of animal stalls, recreations of how Noah and his family may have lived, and even an animatronic version of Noah that will answer questions. This well anticipated attraction is sure to amaze and is truly a one of a kind experience! After touring the Ark, you'll be off for a guided tour of the **Garden of Hope** in Covington, KY. Developed by Rev. Morris Coers after a trip to Palestine in 1938, the garden includes replicas of the tomb where Jesus was buried, a carpenter shop like the one Joseph worked in, the Good Samaritan Inn, a Spanish chapel, and large boulders from the River Jordan. Upon your return to the hotel, you'll enjoy a light dinner reception hosted by the hotel manager, including cold and hot selections and beverages. For those still hungry, there are many restaurants within two blocks of the hotel. (Breakfast, Manager's Reception)



Wednesday, July 27: Explore Fort Ancient Archeological Park

After enjoying a full buffet breakfast at the hotel, you'll check out and board the motorcoach for a guided tour of **Fort Ancient Archeological Park** in Oregonia, OH. Set on a bluff 250 feet above the Little Miami River, this museum of Native American history tells the story of pre European inhabitants. It is part of a 100 acre complex, with miles of earthen walls. Fort Ancient Archeological Park offers exploration and learning both indoors and out. At the museum, visitors can look back at the three major technological themes of American Indian culture. The 9,000 square foot facility is divided into three major themes: The First Ohioans (the initial arrival of the earliest American Indians who followed the movement of big game into the Ohio area), Tillers of the Soil (the transition from hunting and gathering to farming), and When Worlds Collide (first contact with Europeans). The Museum also offers many "touchables" including a small shelter, a drum, and plenty of reproduced artifacts. Fort Ancient also offers over 2.5 miles of hiking trails and two scenic overlooks. Fort Ancient is currently a candidate as a World Heritage Site. After exploring, you depart for home with a meal stop en route. This Tour of Biblical Proportions is a perfect adventure for the whole family! (Breakfast)
